WHERE DO DUES GO?

A question came up from a member wanting to know exactly what our dues pay for. First, the car show is self-supporting through entry fees collected and donations/sponsorships, not funded by members' annual dues. Enough is always held over to cover preliminary costs for subsequent year's show. Charity donations come out of those same funds except the Food Bank Nite which is member contributions. The Christmas Party is paid for by attendee funds and supplemented from our raffle held at each club meeting. Club dues (\$20 per member, \$30 per couple/family) pay for the following:

- Postage - for snail mail newsletter and other information sending, bill paying, Sunshine cards sending, annual mailing to all members, special announcements or fliers, etc.
- Sunshine cards, envelopes for above mailings, occasional gifts or memoriums on behalf of the club, etc.
- Printing costs (professional or to reimburse members' usage such as printer ink) for address labels, annual mailing, special announcements, etc.
- Annual website maintenance fee
- Initial upfront purchase of inventory for t-shirt logo transfers, car plaques and window logos
- Events supplies (entrée and paper products for club picnic, raffle tickets, decorations and materials for 4th of July Parade including entry fee, door prizes for cruises, Food Bank Nite incentive prize [this year 2 free Christmas Party dinners], replacement of tents, tables and other equipment, as condition requires, for use at car shows and other club events, etc.)
- Non-profit tax fees and other professional fees as needed such PO BOX annual rental
- Association fees such as INCCC
